Why should he be able to pump 750 gal a minute & I am limited to 150 gal a day & 15 gal a day per cow? My family has lived here for 92 years & I have lived here for 44 of those years. If I am to run out of water I will be forced to move elsewhere. My wife died here last year on this farm and I hope to die here as well, but that's not going to happen if I am out of water & must move off the farm. Please stop the pumping of all our water. What are the future generations to do if we have no water left? Think of your grand kids, great grand kids, & on down the line. Thank you.
