## **Notice of Hearing Concerning: Proposed Permanent Quarantine**

Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 2-2117, a hearing will be conducted at 1:00 p.m. on January 24, 2024, in room 124, Kansas Department of Agriculture, 1320 Research Park Dr., Manhattan, KS 66502 in the matter of the issuance of a permanent quarantine regarding Callery Pear (*Pyrus calleryana* Decaisne). The proposed quarantine would affect all area within the borders of the State of Kansas and would prohibit movement of regulated items into or within the quarantined area.

Regulated items under quarantine would include the following:

• All seeds, plants, or parts of the plant of Callery Pear (*Pyrus calleryana* Decaisne) capable of growing or propagation.

The public hearing will be conducted in person and via video conferencing system. All interested persons may attend the hearing and will be given the opportunity to express comments either orally or in writing, or both. Interested parties may appear in person or by counsel.

For persons intending to present oral testimony at the hearing, prior notice to the department would be helpful in arranging the agenda.
