

# Area III: Saline County

The Saline County Conservation District from Area 3 prides itself on their work with partners. For a year and a half they have worked with K-State Research & Extension on field trials for cool & warm season forages. The field trial plots were planted at a farm in Eastern Saline County owned by the Saline County Conservation District. Two field days have been held at the farm that included tours and information on the results of the field trials.

The district partners with Saline County Farm Bureau at the yearly 4th Grade Ag Day. This year the district presented the non-inflatable soil tunnel from the NRCS State office.

A partnership with the Key Banker provides the district with the opportunity to organize a public Bankers Award Tour. Each year a different section of the county is toured and highlighted. This year community members enjoyed a windy Kansas day while touring the southeast section of Saline County.

Saline County supports and has teams participate in the regional & state Envirothon competitions held each year for high school students. The district supports youth who want to attend the Kansas Range Youth Camp each year.
